During the week before school, they would like to do training for staff and are working on getting this scheduled.  Tim has been attending the county fairs. He is completely out of swag and is waiting for more stuff to come in. He has been doing a lot of technical assistance and talking to suicide loss survivors. He will be going to Roseau tomorrow. Tim has been working on speaking to the principal at Kittson Central to start a student-led peer support initiative. His goal is to work on changing the culture in the school, so that students have an interest in each other's well-being. He plans to start with the older grades first and will initiate in	Tim/Brenna

		elementary schools in 2026/2027. This is different from Project 11 through the Max Foundation; however, this is another option for schools.  Tim is working on healthcare initiatives with the NW Healthcare Coalition to create a culture of recovery within healthcare institutions.  Tim is working on the Juvenile Justice Initiative, which will put comprehensive training on well-being, trauma-informed care, and suicide prevention into training plans for every Juvenile Detention facility and youth-serving residential facilities.  Tim is looking to provide technical assistance for resilience building, well-being, and suicide prevention. He has been delivering wrist bands and wallet cards and still has lots of yard signs.	
Open Forum	Community updates     Meeting- MS TEAMS	Fran will have a booth at the Marshall County fair this week. She will have resources for 988 and HOPE Coalition. She had the County Collaboration meeting last week, where they came up with a name of Marshall County Thriving Together. They are working on organizing mental health awareness events at sporting events, such as basketball games this winter. These mental health awareness events may include having the players wear t-shirts during warm-ups, a resource fair, a meal, student talk for 5 minutes between games to raise awareness, and inserts to go in roster Jeanna and Fran will be hosting a poverty simulation in August. It is on August 13th from 1:00-4:00 at Northland in Thief River Falls.  Marshall County is working with the Star Legacy Foundation to support families through perinatal loss. There will be 3 sessions: 1 at Sanford in TRF, 1 at the community center in Karlstad, and 1 at LifeCare in Roseau.  Dawn will be attending the Roseau County fair this week. Sarah discussed the upcoming Be The Voice event on September 16th in Thief River Falls. There is an attached Save The Date and the schedule of events will be coming out soon.
